





DETAILED ITINERARY: 13 NIGHTS/ 14 DAYS

DAY 01 – 11 October: Arrival Delhi – Rishikesh

Upon arrival at Delhi airport, proceed directly to **Rishikesh**, the gateway to the Himalayas and a revered pilgrimage town on the banks of the sacred Ganga. After check-in, take time to relax and absorb the serene surroundings. In the evening, gather at **Triveni Ghat** to witness the enchanting **Ganga Aarti**, a powerful ritual of light and devotion. Let the chants, bells, and flickering lamps connect you to the divine flow of the river.

Meals: Dinner

→ Overnight Stay: Hotel in Rishikesh

DAY 02 – 12 October: Rishikesh – Barkot (180 km / 6–7 hrs)

Post **breakfast**, begin your scenic drive to **Barkot** via Chamba and Yamuna Bridge. The route is surrounded by lush forests and mountain views. On arrival, check in to your hotel and unwind. Later, enjoy a freshly prepared **dinner** and rest for the trek to Yamunotri next day.

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Barkot





DAY 03 – 13 October: Barkot – Yamunotri – Barkot (Drive + Trek)

Start your day early with **breakfast**, then drive to **Janki Chatti** (40 km), from where you begin the **6 km trek to Yamunotri**. Visit **Yamunotri Temple**, offer prayers and take a dip in **Surya Kund**. Trek back to Janki Chatti and drive to Barkot by evening. Enjoy a hot **dinner** on arrival.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Barkot

DAY 04 – 14 October: Barkot – Uttarkashi (100 km / 4–5 hrs)

After **breakfast**, check out and drive to **Uttarkashi**, a sacred town on the banks of the Bhagirathi River. Visit the renowned **Kashi Vishwanath Temple** and explore the peaceful surroundings. Relax at the hotel and relish your **dinner**.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Uttarkashi

DAY 05 – 15 October: Uttarkashi – Gangotri (100 km / 4–5 hrs)

Enjoy an early **breakfast** and drive to **Gangotri**, passing through **Harsil Valley** and **Gangotri hot springs**. Reach the holy **Gangotri Temple**, offer darshan and participate in the evening **Ganga Aarti**. Stay at a nearby guesthouse or hotel and enjoy a warm **dinner**.

Overnight Stay: Hotel/Guesthouse in Gangotri

DAY 06 – 16 October: Gangotri – Uttarkashi (Return 100 km)

After a relaxed morning and **breakfast**, begin your return journey to **Uttarkashi**. On arrival, check in to the hotel and spend the evening at leisure. **Dinner** will be served at the hotel.

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Uttarkashi

DAY 07 – 17 October: Uttarkashi – Guptkashi (210 km / 8–9 hrs)

Begin the day with **breakfast**, then drive to **Guptkashi** via **Rudraprayag** and **Agastyamuni**, enjoying views of river confluences and forested valleys. Upon reaching, check in to the hotel, relax, and have **dinner** before preparing for Kedarnath trek.

DAY 08 – 18 October: Guptkashi – Gaurikund – Kedarnath (Drive + Trek)

After **early breakfast**, drive to **Sonprayag** and take a local shuttle to **Gaurikund**, the starting point of the **16 km trek to Kedarnath**. Reach Kedarnath by afternoon/evening, perform darshan at the sacred temple, and attend the mesmerizing **evening aarti**. Enjoy a simple **dinner** at your camp or lodge.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Overnight Stay: Camp/Guesthouse near Kedarnath Temple

DAY 09 – 19 October: Kedarnath – Gaurikund – Guptkashi (Trek + Drive)

After **breakfast**, trek back to **Gaurikund**, then drive to **Guptkashi**. Check in to the hotel and rest after the long journey. Enjoy a delicious **dinner** in the evening.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Guptkashi

DAY 10 – 20 October: Guptkashi – Badrinath (220 km / 8–9 hrs)

After **breakfast**, drive to **Badrinath**, passing through **Chopta** and **Joshimath**. Reach by evening, check in, and proceed for **darshan at Badrinath Temple** followed by evening aarti. Return for a hearty **dinner** at the hotel.

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Badrinath

DAY 11 – 21 October: Badrinath (Local Excursion)

Start the day with **darshan and pooja at Badrinath Ji**, followed by a dip at the sacred **Tapt Kund**. After breakfast, take a short **3 km trek to Vishnu Charan Paduka**, believed to bear the footprint of Lord Vishnu. Spend a few peaceful moments in meditation before trekking back, passing through a traditional **Himalayan village**.

In the evening, visit the **local market near the temple** for shopping or leisurely exploration.

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Badrinath

DAY 12 – 22 October: Badrinath (Local Excursion)

Start your day with **breakfast**, then explore nearby attractions like **Mana Village**, **Vyas Gufa**, **Bhim Pul**, and **Saraswati River origin**. You may also attend special **morning pujas** at the temple. Return by evening for **dinner** and rest.

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Badrinath





DAY 13 – 23 October: Badrinath – Devprayag (225 km / 8–9 hrs)

After **breakfast**, begin your return journey toward **Devprayag**, driving past **Pipalkoti** and **Rudraprayag**. Upon arrival, visit the **confluence of Alaknanda and Bhagirathi Rivers** forming the Ganga. Check in and enjoy a peaceful evening and **dinner**.

Overnight Stay: Hotel in Devprayag

DAY 14 – 24 October: Devprayag – Haridwar – Delhi (310 km / 7–8 hrs)

After breakfast, begin your final descent from the mountains, driving towards **Haridwar**, where the sacred Ganga gracefully enters the plains. Along the way, reflect on the divine blessings received during your transformative **Char Dham** journey.

Upon reaching Haridwar, take a brief pause—rest, visit the sacred ghats, or simply soak in the spiritual ambiance. **Thereafter, continue with a group transfer to Delhi Airport**, departing with a heart full of devotion, sacred memories, and the enduring grace of the Himalayas.


